Sri Konijeti Rosaiah was born in a middle class agricultural family at Vemuru, Guntur Distrcit on 4th July 1933. He has served as student leader of Hindu College, Guntur in 1952 and elected as General Secretary. He elected as a Member of A.P.Legislative Council during 1968, 1974 and 1980. He has also acted as Leader of Opposition in A.P.Legislative Council from 1978.He, elected to the Lok Sabha from Narasaraopet Constituency in the year 1998 and served on various parliamentary committees.

He held the portfolio as Minister for Transport, Roads & Buildings in the Cabinet of Hon'ble Chief Minister Dr.M.Channa Reddy in 1979.As Minister for Transport, Housing and Commercial Taxes in the Cabinet of Chief Minister Sri T.Anjaiah in 1980. As Minister for Home in the Cabinet of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Sri K.Vijaya Bhaskara Reddy in 1982. As Minister for Finance, Power, Transport, Handlooms & Textiles, Higher Education and Legislative Affairs in the Cabinet of Hon'ble Chief Minister Dr.M.Channa Reddy in 1989.As a Minister for Finance, Power and Medical & Health in the Cabinet of Chief Minister Sri. K.Vijaya Bhaskara Reddy in 1992.

He acted as the President, Andhra Pradesh Congress Committee during 1995-1997. He held the Portfolio as Minister for Medical & Health in the Cabinet of Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri N.Janardhan Reddy in 1991 and in the Cabinet of Dr.Y.S.Rajasekhara Reddy from 2005 to June 2006. As Minister for Finance, Planning, and Legislative Affairs Departments in the Cabinet of Hon'ble Chief Minister Dr.Y.S.Rajasekhara Reddy from May 2004 to 02-09-2009. Recipient of Doctorate from Andhra University, Visakhapatnam during October, 2007. He elected to the State Legislative Council during April, 2009. Sworn in as Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh on 3.9.2009

BIO-DATA

Dr. IQBAL SINGH was born on 4th June 1945 in Freedom fighters family, to (late) Sri Lal Singh and (Late) Smt. Santokh Kaur. His father late Shri Lal singh was President of Jalianwala Bah, Amristar, Punjab, During the Massacre carried out by Bristish, and it was by fortune that he survived the torment of British bullets on that fateful day.

He graduated in B.A from Pubjab University in the Year 1969. Even during his college days, he took keen interest in Politics and took speial interest in promotion of Hindi and Pubjabi literature. He represented Indian National Yough Congress in International Youth Festival, 1978 held at Cuba. He held position of General Secretary of Punjab Youth Congress and played a pivotal role in bringing the yough of Punjab into the fold of the Congress Party.

Dr. Iqbal singh has the distinction of holding several significant positions in the Indian National Congress, including Secretary, All Indian Congress Committee for 12 continuous years and is a permanent member of Congress Working Committee. As Member of Parliament of Rajya Sabha from 1992 - 98, he was the member of several important Committees, viz. Tourism, Steel, Scout and Raj Bhasha.

As a man of principles, he championed human values by organising Anti Drug Campaign and Blood Donation Camps. He organised marriages for girls from poor and downtrodden families. He has delivered several keynote talks in Visual media and Radio on important social issues. He was at the forefront in coming to the aid of Bihar flood victims by mobilizing sizeable aid for providing timely relief to the victims.

Seized of the global problem of "Climate change" and "Global Warming", he has been an activie advocate of sustainable practice and has regularly conducted several environment programmes to drive home the importance of reducing emission of green house gases

INAUGURATION OF 24 NOS. OF WEEKLY MARKET SHEDS AT Smt. INDIRAGANDHI MARKET COMPLEX, YANAM

Yanam is being the main business centre and people of sorrounding hamlets of Andhra Pradesh within a radius of 6 Kms. come to weekly market. At present the weekly market (Shandy) in Yanam is being conducted in the streets of Panchala, Yerragunta, Jail Street on every Tuesday . The people of Yanam experiencing a lot of difficulties in Shandy for free flow of traffic, affected by rains in rainy season, and heat in summer. Reports have also been received by the dwellers in view of health and hygienic conditions not to conduct weekly market in and around the above streets. Therefore, the Yanam Municipal Council has proposed to construct 24 Nos. of weekly market sheds attached to daily fish, mutton, chicken and vegetables market at new market complex, Ferry road, Yanam.

Smt. Indira Gandhi Market complex consists of Fish market unit, chicken and mutton shop unit and vegetable shops and was inaugurated on 07.06.2008. Now it is proposed to inaugurate the 24 Nos. of weekly market sheds. The work was completed in all respects and nearly 240 vendors will accommodate in this market for doing their daily / weekly business.

There are many talented youth in Yanam in the field of Sports, Dance, Gymnastics, Drama and other cultural activities for which lack of encouragement they did not compete with other parts of India. This Yanam Peoples Festival creates awareness of competitions among local artists.

Dr. Iqbal Singh has been a sports enthusiast right from his school days and has been an active participant in many sports events. He is actively involved in promoting sports especially in rural sports in Panchayati Level. He is also the founder of All India Surijit Hokey Tournament and He is the chairman of Punjab Sports Welfare Society. He has been a globetrotter and has visited nearly 13 countries. His favourite past time is reading, writing, Listening to Music.

Dr. Iqbal Singh, with his passion for literature, music and education, is advisor for several leading Trusts and Educational Institutions. He is a trustee of "Bhai Vir Singh Sadhan", which promotes Punjabi Sahitya. He was the Chief Patron of 125 years old Institution "Barballabh Sangeeth Maha Sabha", which promotes classical music. He is also trustee of "K.L. Sehgal Memorial". Fond of music composed by Shri Sehgal, he is ardent collector of his music compositions. Unveiling of the Statue of
Dr. Y.S. RAJASEKHARA REDDY

Former Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh
at Draksharama Road, Yanam

After sudden demise of late Dr. Y.S. Rajashekar Reddy, Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh who helped a lot for development of Yanam region as and when required by our Hon'ble Minister for Revenue Sri Malladi Krishna Rao. He had pleased to sanction the following schemes for the benefit of people of Yanam, a small town (Geographically situated in Andhra Pradesh) Union Territory of Puducherry.



1. Allotment of 55 acres of land of Andhra Pradesh for storage of drinking water.
2. Allotment of 1000 sq.ft of land at Tirumala, the premises of Lord Venkateswara for the construction of Guest house at the cost of Rs. 3 crores and further maintenance will be taken by the Tourism Department, Puducherry.
3. He had pleased to allot 75 Kilometer of Land from Dowleswaram to Yanam for laying Drinking water pipe line for supply of 3 cusecs water lifting from Godavari at Dowleswaram. The Govt. of India, the Ministry of Urban Development has sanctioned 31.34 Crores out of total cost of Rs. 39.18 crores for this project. In addition 600 Mts of land was also allotted at Dowleswaram at free fo cost for the construction of Pump house and Guest House.

4. He had also granted permission for maintenance of Draksharama Road from NH214 to Entrance of Yanam at free of cost.

For his helping contribution to people of Yanam, Govt. of Pondicherry agreed to erect 18 feet life style Bronze Statue including further maintenance like widening of roads, lighting, lawns for an amoun tof Rs.30 Lakhs.

The life style bronze statue to unveile by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh SRI K. ROSAIAH on 6-1-2010.
